Important instructions:

FOR PROSPECTIVE STUDENTS FOR ADMISSION TO B-ARCHITECTURE

1. Candidate should remain present at the time of counseling. In case if the candidate is not able to remain present personally, due to serious illness, accident or unavoidable circumstances, his parents or guardian shall, **after obtaining prior approval of the Committee (ACPC)** or any other authorized by the Committee, remain present on the scheduled date time and place. **An authority letter** signed by the candidate showing his order of preference and choice of branches and colleges or institutions shall have to be produced by the parents or guardian who shall remain present in his behalf, **along with the documentary** evidence showing reason for the absence or inability to remain present personally.
2. In case candidate reporting late, when his/her merit number is crossed, the candidate will get chance of admission on vacant seats at the time of reporting, irrespective of his/her earlier merit number.
3. The candidate shall bring with them the following original supporting documents.
 - a. Mark-sheet of the qualifying examination (HSC/ Diploma/ Fy.B.Sc./etc.)
 - b. NATA score card (Internet copy from NATA website is Acceptable)
 - c. Mark-sheet of 10th Class
 - d. School leaving certificate/Transfer certificate/ equivalent certificates.
 - e. Caste certificate (if applicable)
 - f. Valid non-creamy layer certificate (if applicable)
 - g. Certificate of Physical disability (if applicable)
 - h. Certificate of In/Ex-Servicemen (if applicable)
 - i. Certificate of Jammu and Kashmir (J&K) Migrants or residents (If applicable)
4. Tuition fee is not same for all the colleges. After obtaining admission the candidate shall have to pay a token fee in cash, the maximum amount of which may be up to Rs. 20,000. At the BANK counter inside the ACPC building
5. Only one person shall accompany the candidate at the time of counseling.
6. After confirming final admission, the candidates have to report / register at the institute within 5 working days, and pay the remaining fees to the respective institutes.
