Sub.: Guidelines for filling of vacant seats (Without GATE/GPAT or CET) for M.E./M.Pharm. courses at your Institute.

Ref.: Education Dept., Govt. of Gujarat Notification No.GH/SH/57/2011/PRC/102011/1358/S dated 18th October, 2011

The Education dept. vide above referred notification (available on our website) has granted permission to respective institutes to fill the vacant seats (Without GATE/GPAT or CET) **strictly as per following rules and guidelines.** Accordingly following procedure and guidelines has to be followed to fill the vacant seats at your institute.

1. Applications are to be invited for vacant seats by giving wide publicity in form of display on institute website or other appropriate means.
2. **The admission should be granted as per following priority in order of merit.**
 - i) The first priority should be given to GATE/GPAT qualified candidates whose names appear in the ACPC merit list.
 - ii) The second priority should be given to Non GATE/Non GPAT candidates who have appeared in CET 2011 conducted by ACPC and their names appear in ACPC merit list.
 - iii) The third priority should be given to candidates who have passed qualifying examination as per Appendix I of Admission Amendment rule, 2011 and have qualified GATE/GPAT and whose names are not in ACPC merit list. **This priority is applicable only in the disciplines where merit list of ACPC has totally exhausted. The list of disciplines in which merit list of ACPC is totally exhausted is given below.**
 - iv) The fourth priority should be given to candidates who have passed qualifying examination as per Appendix I of Admission Amendment rule, 2011 but have neither qualified GATE/GPAT nor appeared in CET 2011 i.e. their names are not in ACPC merit list. **This priority is also applicable only in the disciplines where merit list of ACPC has totally exhausted. The list of disciplines in which merit list of ACPC is totally exhausted is given below.**
 - v) In case of fourth priority the merit list should be prepared based on marks obtained in the final year of qualifying examination.

The list of disciplines where merit list of ACPC has totally exhausted is as follows.

- 1) Civil Engineering
- 2) Chemical Engineering
- 3) Environment Engineering
- 4) Information Technology
- 5) Mechanical Engineering
- 6) Metallurgy
- 7) Textile Engineering
- 8) Pharmacy

3. The above process shall have to be completed by **21st October, 2011** and the institute has to submit the admitted list of candidates for endorsement by the ACPC with the following documents:
 - a) Proof of display on institute website.
 - b) Applications of candidates issued and received at institute with its register.
 - c) Inter-se merit list
 - d) Copy of attendance register
 - e) Proof of cancellation of admission at institute level (if candidate has already taken admission in other institute)
 - f) Admitted list of students.
 - g) Fee receipt

4. The entire admission procedure is to be conducted as per Education department Notification No. GH/SH/11/2009/PVS/102009/553/S dt. 29-05-2009 and its amendments dt.24.06.2009, 22-07-2009, 17.07.2010 and 6.8.2011 all available on this committee's website.

The vacant seats are to be filled strictly as per above procedure. Further the entire process has to be carried out in highly transparent manner, the responsibility of the same will lie with the Principal of concerned institute.
